## Medical campaign

In the period of January 16<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> we had a medical campaign. A group of North-American medical doctors and nurses came to Peru to give free medical attention. We visited different neighborhoods. At Quilmaná we encountered a very sad case of a lady who had several serious problems. She had physical, emotional, mental and socio-economic problems.

# Youth Camps

Our first camp was with <u>pre-adolescents</u> (January 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>), they excitedly participated in worship and competitions, and enjoyed good spiritual food. I thank God for the opportunity to give a workshop together with a brother on 'Jesus our real Influencer and how we can <u>be influencers' for Christ'</u>. We also\_prepared a theatre on the life of Job for the parents. Job didn't have any technology, but he was an influencer approved by God because of the spiritual quality of his life.

I thank God for the unexpected opening to give a lecture to the parents. This addressed the dangers & risks in the social media. The goal was to create awareness in the parents to take care of their children, instruct them in the Word and not give away their lives to the enemy that is behind the social media.

The theme for the camp of the <u>adolescents</u> (January  $31^{st}$  to February  $3^{rd}$ ) was the same as that of the pre-adolescents. We gave a

workshop on the dangers in social media and how to protect themselves. The last camp (February 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>) was for <u>kids of 6 to 8 years</u>. Their enthusiasm was remarkable, especially, when we were praising God and competing in teams. During this camp I gave two bible classes.

One class was on how God had protected David when he was in danger of death because of king Saul (1Samuel 18-19). The other class addressed how God took care of Job during his illness and eventually restored him (Job 1-3 and 42.) Let's pray that the kids will remember and apply these truths to their lives.
