Evelyng's Health:

My wife had two breast surgeries in May. She had to have a biopsy, which thanks to God the results were favorable. But she still had an infection and required an operation. It was a stressful time, but also encouraging to see God guiding and taking care of her. The second surgery was for a hemorrhage that occurred while I was traveling. But undoubtedly, God took care of her better than I could and she is now recovering.

This month we will have an appointment with the doctor and begin check-ups. Please pray that the infection will be completely eliminated and that the inflammation disappears.





Above all, join us in praying that God would fulfill His purposes in our family in the midst of this uncomfortable situation. We continue to praise Him, remembering Job, who worshipped God even when he had lost everything.

Trip to Colombia and the Peruvian Jungle:

In April I took a trip to teach God's Word in a youth camp in Tulúa, in the Cauca Valley in Colombia. It was an exhausting but satisfying trip. The first week I taught the youth, and the second I taught couples and students of the seminary in Tulúa. We finished by teaching the men of the church, creating contacts to



follow up on if God allows, and training leaders for the next generation with the truth of God. In May I was able to visit the jungle of my country, where I taught the students in the Mobile Bible Institute for a week. It's a challenging opportunity and a great encouragement not only to share the Holy Scriptures, but also to train pastors and leaders in the church so that they can do the same with others (2 Timothy 2:2).



Teaching in the Church: We continue with the building up of the church by thematic teaching each Sunday in our main church, La Roca. We praise God that the church has grown and is being strengthened with families who lead, not only with loyalty and faithfulness, but also with the firm foundation of God in their families and lives. We are seeing new generations, and we desire to see them loving God and defending His Word - passionate for His eternal work.

Family Groups: We continue teaching families each Friday with the goal of establishing them in the foundations of the Word of God. Many of them are new families in our church, but hungry to know more of the Scriptures. God has opened doors for us, and we want to be faithful in sharing God's principles with these families. We thank God for the faithfulness of the brothers and their desire to learn and grow.



Youth: In this time of trial, the youth of our church have been an encouragement in our lives. They have been attentive to our family, and our church families have watched over Evelyng and our sons while I was travelling. They have strengthened us in the Lord, and we conclude that our work in the Lord is not in vain. We see how God works through His people, the church, and amen for that. We continue teaching them the Word of God every Saturday and all three youth groups are growing spiritually and are growing in numbers. We desire to be an example for them by living out the Word of God.



Our Children, David and Nathan: They have been watching how we react to these trials, and we pray that God would grow their faith. Who knows if this will be the way that God works in them and allows them to know Him personally. Our prayer is that they would have a real and sincere relationship with Christ, and that God in His SOVEREIGNTY would use this situation to bring them to Christ as well.
