We have been serving our God by training young people with the objective and goal that they will be in the future, if God wills, leaders who can take responsibility for the ministry that God gives them. In our church we are going through a noteworthy time of transition of



generations, and we desire a new generation fearful of God and zealous for His truth. This is why we are being intentional with this work with those who will come after us (2 Timothy 2:2).

New Families: This year especially, our church has grown in numbers and also in new families. Therefore, every Friday we have been laying the foundation of faith in them, studying the book of the Acts of the Apostles. Our goal is to give them a firm foundation in what we believe and affirm. We thank God for giving us the opportunity with them. Each Friday we see in these family gatherings not only their faithfulness, but the interest and hunger for the Word of God in



these families. Pray that they will continue to have the desire to continue to



grow (2 Peter 2:2), and thus be steadfast in the faith.

Teaching: As a church, we continue to teach through the expository

The goal was to work with the leadership of brothers from different churches in that area, to strengthen them in the work they do, and also to encourage

the young people who accompanied us in the missionary work.



We pray that this trip was not only a challenge, but also that God will use it to awaken in them an interest and commitment to missions. The trip lasted a week, and we spent an enriching time studying God's Word and God's call to a new generation.

As for us, brothers &

sisters, we are being challenged to grow more as a family. Our prayer is that we will be an example and challenge to the people God allows us to minister to (Titus 2:7). Also that God would give us His wisdom to be good children and parents, since our children are growing physically and we see the need to be an example to them. We pray especially that in the grace of God, they know the Lord as their Savior and Lord as well, and may they show the fruit of their salvation. Meanwhile, we continue not only praying for the salvation of David and Nathan, but also continue to sow the Word of God in their hearts.

Evelyng is still in observation for the health problem she has. It is chronic, but controlled, and she continues to disciple women and youth. She also helps in the teaching of the ladies group in our church and in



the prenatal center with counseling.

In addition, brothers and sisters, we share our desire to be able to visit you, if God allows, and share with you personally what God has been doing all these years in and with us. We would also like for you to be able to meet our children in person. This is our desire, and we share it with you so you can join in praying with us before our good God.
