They were from many tribes: Curipacos, Puinaves, Cubeos, Piapocos, and Piaroas. It was a privilege to share with them the Word of God and to present the Gospel to them. Twenty-three youth gave their lives to Jesus. I was also able to have a good time of counseling with the pastors and leaders. Together with World Reach missionaries we were able to organize the Mobile Bible Institute with leaders from the tribes. God willing, we will begin class in February 2024. This will be a big part in filling the need the former students have concerning the generations behind them. Please pray as we pass the torch; may the light grow and illuminate brighter. They are currently struggling with drugs, guerrilla warfare, religious sects, politics, misuse of the internet, etc.

Upon returning to Argentina, my wife and I have continued with discipleship and counseling. Also, I was able to teach in a conference in Cordoba.

Please join us in praying for a conference for women. My wife will be sharing the testimony of Sophie Muller, and she will teach the Word of God.
