I recently returned from my second trip this year to Kenya. It has been said the job of a CEO is to bring change, which is what resulted from this trip. We celebrated the retirement of our

outgoing director of 35 years. I then promoted and appointed new leaders from our staff with renewed vision and a passion for Christ. The Kenyan team has already brought hope and change to our ministries. The Lord led me to rename our orphanage to the World Reach Children's Home. I was praying and thinking about the words of Jesus in John 14:18, "I will not leave you as orphans." They are no longer orphans but part of the World Reach family! This has brought hope, life, and smiles to many. Patrick directs the children's home and takes the kids to the church he pastors every Sunday. When I preached there, three of our children indicated a desire to be missionaries! My goal for these children is to walk in the truth (3 John 4) and grow up to be full-time Christians, and hopefully, God will call some into vocational service as missionaries to reach the unreached in Africa.

Sadly, Tonny, our accountant in Meru, Kenya, who disappeared on November 8, has not resurfaced. The situation is still a mystery. Thank you for your prayers and concern.

- · Colombia Staff retreat January 7-13, 2024.
- Master plan development for our Meru, Kenya campus includes a well, dining hall, modern kitchen, dormitories for training, solar power backup, a computer lab, library, and study area for the children.
- Completion of construction on Muthetheni, Kenya campus for teachers / visiting doctor apartment, additional bathroom facilities, and a storage building that can also house cooking staff for events.
- · I plan to return in spring 2024 to Kenya for the next steps.
- · Continuing the vision to mobilize from anywhere to reach everywhere.
