Thank you for your love and participation with our family in ministry through World Reach. We recently finished 3 excellent weeks of children and youth summer camps near Lima and we've done many evangelistic activities, which ended this busy summer ministry season in Peru. In our three summer camps, we had 266 children and youth who heard the Gospel clearly and learned about Jesus. Then, in Medical clinic outreaches from February 12-14 with a mission team from the USA, 880 people were served and also heard the Gospel! We give glory to God for His work through all these outreaches!

During the 3 camps, we had the opportunity to teach and minister and also continue training a new generation to serve God. It was encouraging to have young people from our church serving. As kids, they were campers and now they have become helpers, dedicating their entire summer to serve alongside us. It's our desire for others in the next generation to rise up and serve with the same dedication and love for Christ and His work. What an encouragement to see that our work in Christ through the years is not in vain. We pray that this next generation will continue to grow and increase and that we will decrease. IF THE LORD WILLS, OUR MINISTRY TRIPS FOR 2024 MAY INCLUDE:

- Camps and teaching in Tulua, Colombia in April/May.
- Teaching pastors and church leaders at World Reach Mobile Bible Institutes in Laos from April 15-19 and Cuevas June 24-28.
- Bryan is invited to teach pastors and leaders at a church in Manchay, outside of Lima.
- Trip to Cusco to bring youth mission team to do VBS in November/December.
- Trip to Cuevas in July to do an Evangelistic Medical Outreach.
- Evelyng is invited to Curacao to help with the teaching at a women's conference in September/October.
- We have invitations for family camps in Bogota, Colombia in November.

An example of fruit from prior camps is Roxana and Paul pictured here. Roxana participated in our youth groups for 12 years and attended camps. She grew up and became a pastor's wife. She married Paul, a pastor in Cusco. God weaves everything into His perfect plans. God allowed us to invite Roxana and Paul to come and teach in our camps in Lima, and we visited and learned of the needs at their church in Cusco. We now plan to bring a mission team of young people from our church to Cusco in November or December to do a Vacation Bible School and train our young people in missions and evangelism.



Like all missionaries with World Reach, we raise support for personal and ministry needs as we follow the Lord in reaching the people of Peru and throughout Latin America for Christ. We currently have only 35% of what we are responsible to raise for World Reach. Would you please pray that God will provide the remaining support of \$2,300 monthly to enable His calling on our family's lives? We deeply appreciate your prayer support. Prayer is the most important thing and must precede anything else we wish to do for the cause of Christ. Our desire is to continue to be faithful and grow in grace. We send you a big hug from Peru. May the God of all grace work in you both to will and to work for His good pleasure.
