It is wonderful to be able to share the latest news of what God has allowed me to do these last three months. It has been a privilege to work with the coordinators, students, and teachers of each of the Bible Institutes (BIs) in Colombia and in other places.

### Cordoba – Preliminary BI Class in April

I taught a preliminary BI course to 23 students in April at our BI in Montelibano, Cordoba. It was great to see what the Lord did in this class, and how the flipped classroom form of study is fulfilling its purpose of helping the students to learn better. We see this in the personal study time that each student puts in and in their participation and interaction in the live classes, which have produced good results. Testimonies of how God guided them to recognize how their heart is with regard to serving God and others, was one of the biggest impacts that I heard the most during the class.

I also had the opportunity to meet online with the 4 coordinators of each of the BIs that we are founding in Colombia. My plan is to encourage them to carry out God's work in the people that want to be trained, and that they would also prepare themselves for be an example for the students.
