



Serving in Honduras - June 2024 NOEL & REINA GOMEZ

Beloved fellow collaborators in the expansion of the Kingdom of God,

We hope that the grace of our God is with each of you. We are grateful to God, and we thank you for your prayers and offerings for the ministry. We thank God that the local church ministries in CFC and Balibrea (such as the children's nutrition center) are functioning well up to this point. Please pray that this ministry would continue, as it has served as a tool to reach many families with the gospel.

Another way we minister to families in these communities is through school supply scholarships. These scholarships are distributed at the beginning of the school year every January, and they allow children and young adolescents to attend classes throughout the year. Each child or young person needs \$80 per year.

We are also praying to replicate these ministries (children's nutrition center and scholarships) in the mountains where we are planting new churches among the Lenca people group. Plans have begun to create a children's nutrition center along with providing a kindergarten education. Please pray that God continues to provide for these ministries.



We thank God for providing the necessary funds for the construction of the first building in the village of Quesuntega. This building will serve as a meeting place for the growing new church in this area. We have already started laying the blocks for the walls. It will be ready very soon.



Last weekend, the first church service was held under the blazing sun where this building is being constructed. Twenty-one people from our local church went to invite and pray for the people. Many attended the service and many received Christ as their Lord and Savior. We will have new baptisms soon.

We give honor and glory to our God because this is the first of many churches that, together with you, we will be planting to magnify our God.

- For God to protect us.
- For God to provide for each of the ministries.
- For the new pastors and leaders of these new churches.
- For our vehicles to always be in good condition so we can travel to these areas.
- For the health of our family that God will always provide what is necessary.
- For jobs for the people in the Lenca area, as it is one of the poorest places in Honduras with an average income of \$0.50 \$0.75 per family, per day.
- For the many communities that do not have water, and for the communities that are consuming very poorquality water, which is leading to many gastrointestinal diseases.

Regarding the ministry in the mountains, we are sending you a map of the Lenca area so you can pray for each of these places. We pray that God will grant us His grace and will provide opportunities to present Jesus Christ as the only and sufficient Savior. Most of these places have never heard the gospel. This area is inhabited by descendants of the Lenca indigenous people. The municipal area where we are working is called Guajiquiro, consisting of 14 villages and 140 groupings of a few houses.
