
Beloved brothers and sisters who are collaborating with us in the extension of God's Kingdom, I address you with great joy. I hope you are enjoying abundant blessings in all that you do.

We are doing construction in the mountains of the Lenca region of Honduras, where most of you know we are on a mission to bring the gospel to these unreached areas with the intention of establishing new churches.

God has allowed us to reach many communities with the gospel where, with the help of Pastor Jesús Corea, we have established contact in at least ten communities. Of these, three are already in the process of planting a new church. The places for the new church plants are Quesuntega, El Pinar, and San José. I know there are seven other communities, but we have seen more active growth in the last few


months in these three than in the others. The beautiful part of all this is witnessing new converts almost every week; we already have a new group of people wanting to be baptized.

These new believers travel between half an hour to three hours to attend services. Because their homes are so small we have decided that, along with the new church plant, we will be constructing buildings in different locations so that the new believers and the established church in the villages have a place to worship and preach the Word of God. In Quesuntega, we are already quite advanced in terms of many new believers and the establishment of a new church. By God's blessing, we are also close to finishing the first building of the first church planted in the Lenca region. All this is thanks to God's blessing and your collaboration.



On this occasion, I want to thank God for keeping us safe on our last trip to the mountains. The car that God has lent us had a mechanical failure with its brakes, and we were close to losing our lives. But by the grace of my God and your constant prayers, God kept us alive.

The last trip was a bit uncomfortable as interesting things happened. First, as I mentioned, the incident with the car; then a metal beam fell on my head from a height of about 5 meters; after that, there was rain; and we were without electricity to weld the roof of the building for almost 24 hours. Fortunately, we brought a generator, which unfortunately broke down seriously by the end of the day. The return trip home after four days of work in the mountains, which usually takes two and a half to three hours, took six hours. But thanks to God, we were able to arrive safely. We are already planning the next work trip to lay the cement floor in what will be the new church in Quesuntega, but for this, I ask for the following prayer requests:
