Have I shared what He has given me? Here are some ministry activities for which I am thankful, and through which others have been able to thank God as well.

Youth Camp

In early August, the "180" youth ministry had its annual camp. As I mentioned in my last prayer letter, the theme was the Summer Olympics, relating it to the theme of the race of faith. The Lord allowed us to have an excellent time of getting closer to His word with the youth, and several of them commented that they felt challenged to seek Him more, and to "fight the good fight, finish the race, and keep the faith."

"Clue" Evangelistic Play

For God's glory, our mystery evangelistic play was a success. I would like to specifically thank for the donations for this ministry, as they allowed me to purchase 4 wireless microphones that were a great blessing in the play and for smaller skits. Some numbers from the play:

- More than 50 people were serving in different areas the 3 nights of the play.
- More than 1500 people watched the play live.
- About 40 people trusted Jesus Christ as their Savior. Glory be to Him!

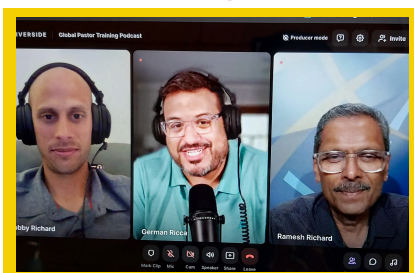
"Encore" Ministry

In August there came an opportunity to deepen the arts focus of the ministry I do with World Reach by teaching some extracurricular music classes at a local Christian school. I presented the idea of a ministry project based on Psalm 98:1 "Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things." The project is called Encore, and its purpose is to raise up the next generation of worship leaders in churches through the teaching of musical instruments, combined with teaching the Word of God. For now, I am teaching two days a week, and the older students have already had their first presentation. We hope to have the next presentation in December, with Christmas songs. Pray that God will take this project where He wants it to go.



Global Pastor Trainers Podcast

This year, at a World Reach event, I met a brother who was interested in my support with a podcast. Some time later, I was contacted by the Global Proclamation Commission to be one of the producers of the Global Pastor Trainers Podcast. I have been collaborating with them for the past 4 months, and it is exciting to see how far reaching the work they do to support pastor trainers worldwide is. The podcast is usually recorded in



English, but using Artificial Intelligence, we translate the voices into 3 more languages (Spanish, French and Portuguese). To God be the glory for the opportunity to collaborate with other people who also have the mission of training pastors!

The growth group: We meet every week, and we are trying to focus on creating a culture of unity, intentional discipleship, depth of spiritual growth and a sense of belonging.
