Our heart for using felt community needs to bridge the gap and reach the unreached is based on how Jesus did ministry in **Matthew 9:35-38**. To us this is a call to action.

Such has enabled us to reach out to 8 schools in September and October, reaching out to about 6500 learners and presenting the gospel to them. As a result, we have lives impacted for the Kingdom.

We have had doors open for us to reach places that would have otherwise been impossible if it was not the doing of the Lord. Such include a dialogue on Mental Health and Teachers' "wellbeing" hosted by the Ministry of Education, Eswatini in October. That led to another one in Lusaka, Zambia for senior education officers in the country's Ministry of Education which took a whole week from December 2-6. Talk of divine connections for maximum impact!

We look back with joy at how the Lord has helped us. We look forward with earnest expectation to what He is yet to help us accomplish in 2025.

1. Ministry of Education Dialogue

The Ministry of Education, Eswatini held a policy dialogue in October and one of the issues deliberated on was teacher well-being. I was tasked to present a paper and a recommendation on a way forward pertaining to such. What an opportunity! In that meeting sat the regional director of programs-UNESCO, whom the Lord used to connect us with the Zambian Ministry of Education which was to hold a training on the same for its senior education officials. I was asked to be one of the facilitators in that training.
