Youth retreat - Villavicencio



Almost 110 young people, most of them non-believers and from very difficult circumstances. Broken homes, suicides, assaults, and so on. Some of them spend their daily lives stealing on the streets and selling drugs. This is perhaps one of the most challenging camps I have ever served in. We thank God for the opportunity to boldly share the Gospel.

One of them, two weeks after the camp, was shot while stealing. These days, he is in the ICU. We have been praying that all of this will help him understand the Gospel that we taught him.

Youth retreat - Armenia





This camp was calmer. Most of them were young believers. It was a time to encourage them and challenge them in their sexual purity. We were able to address topics such as pornography, masturbation, dating, and holiness.

Mobile Bible Institue - Puerto Inirida



For a week, we were teaching our indigenous brothers and sisters. We spent 8 hours a day sharing with them. There were several challenges while teaching, such as language differences and the high temperature and humidity. However, the Holy Spirit doesn't need perfect conditions to be glorified.
