Please pray that God will mobilize some to become international missionaries and for the entire church to embrace the Great Commission and Great Commandment. Our theme will be to "Seize every Gospel Opportunity and Take Christ to the Nations."

On April 25, I will be traveling to Kenya with Dr. Smith and William to take part in a medical outreach in Muthetheni. We are expecting to see 400-600 patients in two days! Please pray the spiritual and physical needs are met during this outreach to the community. We need about \$2000 to cover the medicine and staff-related expenses. After that, my companions return to the USA, and I will stay and work with our team in Meru, designing a building project that will be for our Children's Home and pastor training. We are also looking to discover the best site for a well on our property. We need a clean water source for the children, team, and pastors we train. I can report we were able to convert our property from a lease to a deed now in the name of World Reach. Now, we will repeat the process for our campus in Muthetheni. The construction of a teacher apartment, a storage building with quarters for our event cooks, and more bathroom facilities will begin next week.

Progress since the leadership transition has been amazing. The children are happy under Patrick's leadership, and our team, under Isaac's leadership, has made significant advances on both campuses. Lydiah, our new internal accountant, is doing great with the records and financial details. Our office is remodeled in Meru, and the World Reach Kenya Board is being challenged and trained to prepare for a bright future for our ministries in Kenya. Patrick sent me a plan today for tutoring our children to improve their academics.

The last 15 months since my transition has been quite a journey. Sometimes, we experience great joy; sometimes, there is pain and tears, but such is life when people are involved. I am learning more about Paul's statement, mentioning his concern for the churches he planted (2 Cor 11:28). Please pray that I will faithfully shepherd our team with wisdom and grace.
