What is going on in the family?

We thank God that He has been so gracious in our daughter Michelle's health. She has continued with her severe cough and allergy crises, although she has been under treatment for 4 months since November of last year. After several consultations with different pediatricians, and several tests, including an MRI, we were able to verify that Michelle has a severe inflammation in the right sinus. With this diagnosis and the appropriate medications we have seen a great improvement in her this week, the cough has subsided quite a bit. We are so thankful to God for His goodness in Michelle's life and ours. It is so comforting to our hearts to remember that the God of Isaiah 40:15-18 is the same God we live by and serve today and that nothing is beyond His control.

Hana and Eliana are in the final stretch of their school year, excited to finish that stage. They are preparing to participate in a business fair for the Co-Op group, using their God-given artistic skills, painting and creating miniatures, among other things. In January they had the opportunity to be involved in ministry with a missionary group from North Carolina that was working in our church. It was a special time for them, they helped in evangelism, we rejoiced to see them serving the Lord with their skills and gifts.

Ministry

In these last 3 months God has allowed us to serve Him in different areas such as preaching, training, teaching children and youth, women, and we are in the process of writing the course "Discipleship for small groups" for Biblical movil institute (BMI) courses. We continue to support some local churches with training for Sunday school leaders and teachers. God opened the opportunity to share these trainings online to other countries like Peru and Ecuador and in other parts of Honduras, so we are planning to move the workshops to the World Reach virtual classroom, to be able to support teachers in other parts.

It is so special to hear IBM teachers tell their testimony about how the classes have been a blessing to the students and how God has spoken to their hearts through them, and shown them things they had not seen before. One pastor shared that he had never thought about the motivations for why he does what he does, that really understanding the reality of his heart showed him who he was and who God was.

This is a work that cannot be quantified, although we like to have an exact number for statistics. But we are sure that God is working in the hearts of those who are trained through Biblical movil institute (BMI). God, in his mercy, allows us to be his collaborators. We are glad and encouraged to see the work of the Holy Spirit in the life of every pastor and leader who is getting to know God better. And without you this would not be possible.
