
What is going on in the family?

In these last few months God has allowed us to serve Him in training Sunday school teachers, teaching children, women and classes at the SEBCAH Bible Seminary. In the church in Balibrea God has allowed us to help with the teaching of the Word and the training of the Sunday school teachers. In the musical area, Hector has helped in teaching guitar. A children's choir is also being formed. In past letters we asked for your prayers for someone to help us in the area of music and singing at the church in Balibrea, and God sent Sister Yolanda, a believer with experience in music ministry. It was so amazing to see how God sent our sister Yolanda as an answer to prayer.

We have visited the community of El Duraznal to train Sunday school teachers, pastors and Christian leaders from the Lenca churches. In our last visit we had a group of 12 leaders and pastors who are preparing to fulfill their pastoral calling in the Lenca area. Also, in these months God allowed us to provide them with materials for the Sunday schools, such as chairs, tables and didactic material for the children.







On the other hand, we continue walking hand in hand with God with the World Reach Online program, in recent months we have had visits from people from different countries such as: Ecuador, Mexico, Colombia, Chile, Bolivia, Portugal, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, El Salvador, France, Spain, Peru, Nicaragua, China, Canada, Sweden, Nigeria, Argentina, Peru, etc. We see God's faithfulness in allowing us to reach more people through this medium, especially leaders and pastors in need of training in their available time and at no cost.

We have had a good response to the online teacher workshops. What do you want to show me, Lord? When we listened to the sister we felt so much joy in our hearts because that is really the most important thing in our teachings and trainings, that each person be the first recipient of the teachings of the Lord through His Word. If we learn to be the first recipient of God in everything, we will be leaders according to the heart of God, to help others with the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
