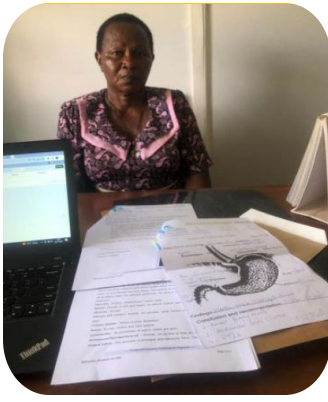




Taking Christ to the Nations

A few laboratory tests were done, and our Clinic Pastor prayed for her. Then she was referred to a level 5 hospital for further investigations where she was diagnosed with a mass on the duodenum. She is currently being managed by a surgeon and doing well. Through health talks, emotional encouragement, and spiritual guidance, we have witnessed her facing adversity with unwavering courage. The journey has not only been about medical treatments, but also about fostering a belief in the healing power of faith.



Paul Mwema's Smile of Resilience

One such individual who has become an integral part of our journey is a resilient soul named Paul. He battles hypertension and was recently diagnosed with dilated cardiomyopathy and bladder outlet obstruction. He has found solace and strength within our clinic's walls as he continues with his treatment by a cardiologist at Karen hospital. Paul comes to our clinic for catheterization and for refills of hypertensive drugs. He is currently doing well. We don't just provide medical treatment, we offer a comprehensive support system - emotionally, psychologically, and spiritually.



Faith Kaluki: Narrative of Fortitude

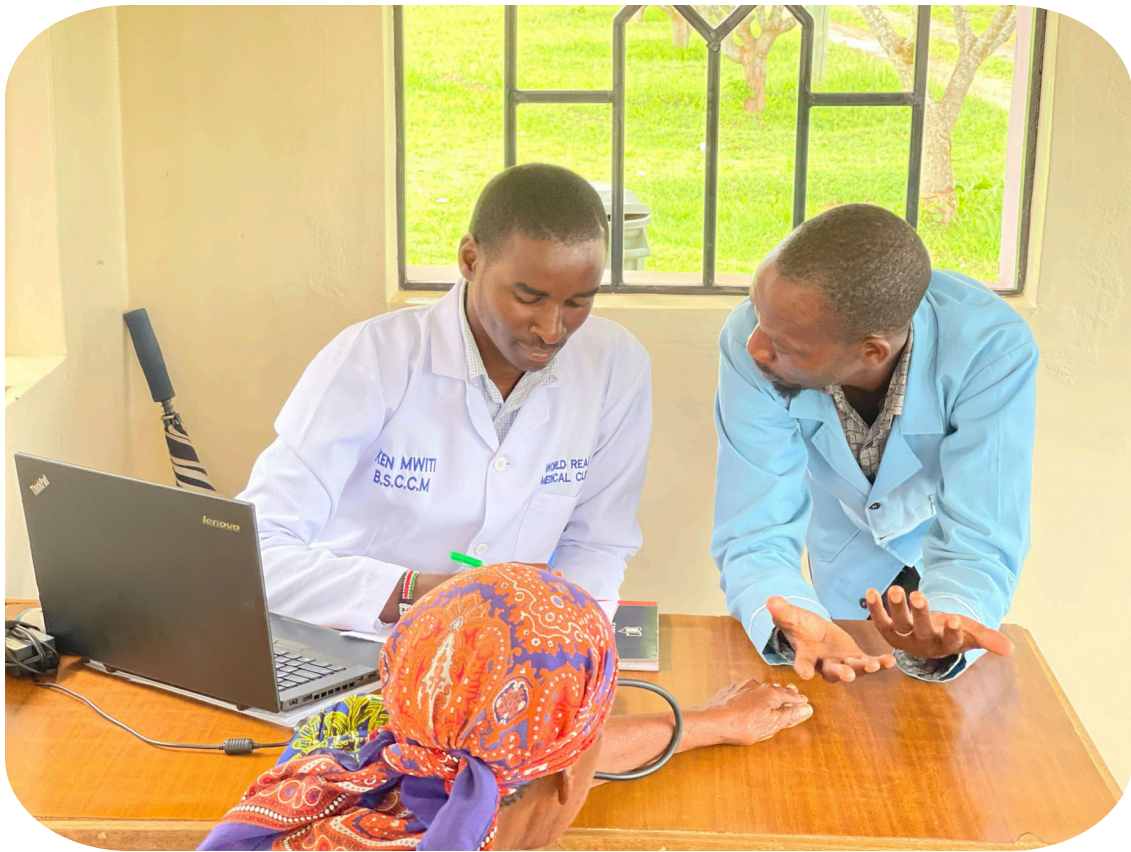

Later, she had to have both of her legs amputated at Kijabe Hospital. As one of service to the community, Reuben the nurse has been taking home-based care services to her such as: wound cleaning & dressing, painkillers & antibiotics, and encouragement. Faith can't come to the Clinic because of financial constraints and the long distance (approx. 10 kms). We thank God that she has reported a marked improvement.
