Camps:

God has allowed us to complete four weeks of camps. It was a time of great activity and satisfaction as well. We started with the children's week, with approximately 83 children; then the youth week with 78; then young adults with 62; and ending with younger children, with 91. As we looked at the team we were working with, we saw not only a team involved and dedicated, but also see in them new leaders for the future.



During the camps, we were not only able to preach the gospel and teach the Word of God with main topics and workshops, but at the end of each week, we had an opportunity to share Christ with several of the parents of campers. In the wake of the camps, our groups for children, teens, and young adults are growing in number. We pray that they remain in the Truth and grow in it.





Evangelistic campaigns:

We had a medical team from the US visit us, and we had the opportunity to serve in the community through medical assistance in different areas. We took the gospel to people in 5 different places, and we had approximately 80 - 100 people in attendance per place.

We thank our Great God who still uses us, and we thank Him especially for the people He brought to the medical campaigns. They were mostly people who did not know Christ as Savior, and we were able to share the one God and Savior with them.
