1. Saved souls: We thank God for the lives that accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior in our outreaches.

2. Trainer Development: We held our on-going training of our trainers on the 8th of February.

3. Staff Development: Through this open door we are able to develop teachers professionally while retaining multiple opportunities to present the gospel.

4. Peer Educators Development Seminars: We thank God for the opportunity to continue with this initiative.

5. Mental Health mentees: In a first, we held a vision casting and orientation session for seven young professionals on March 15.

6. Student Seminars: We thank God for the open door to minister to churches and organizations on mental health issues.

Updates

1. Trainer Development

We held our on-going training of our trainers on the 8th of February. The purpose was to pray together and lay a solid foundation for the year ahead. What a time of fellowship we had as a team of trainers!

2. Staff Development

Through our professional outreaches the following groups have been touched:

- **Ministry of Education Officials:** The Ministry of Education, ETGPS (Guidance and Counselling Unit) held a team building workshop and World Impact was asked to facilitate. What an opportunity we had as we impacted the 48 ministry officials who participated.
- Schools: To date we have reached out to 8 schools with about 300 teachers; making a professional and spiritual impact in the lives of these teachers.
- Head of Departments (HoD's): In a first, we held a 1-day professional training with HoD's for English and Religious Education in Hhhohho and Shiselweni regions. This saw us reach out to 65 and 88 teachers respectively. Such an opportunity allows us to have a foothold where we would otherwise not have had one. As a result, we are seeing more open doors to go to the schools next term to conduct in-house staff developments for the teachers.

3. Peer Educators Development Seminars

Our on-going Student Trainers development is an opportune moment for us to engage them for purposes of discipleship and mentorship in order to minister holistically in our outreach to students through our Study with Success program. We have a team of 13 young people that we are working with.
