We moved to our house in a beautiful rural location. It was an event we had been waiting for months, and we could not stop thanking God for his goodness in giving us a house of our own. However, that same day in the evening, Hector's brother, Ricardo, told us that Hector's mother, Ritha, had gone to the presence of our great God, after 10 years of living with cancer. It was a very difficult time, but at the same time with hope that now she is not in pain, since the last few months her health condition was very difficult. God in his goodness provided the ticket so that Hector could travel to Ecuador and arrive in time for the wake and share with his family, especially his brother. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts, because we know that many of you have been supporting us in prayer for her health.

The first two weeks in the new house were special and difficult at the same time, because we had to be the 4 women alone to organize the house. At the beginning there was a little fear in the girls, but as we prayed and spent each day we saw and felt God's presence and care. We thank God because it has been a great opportunity for them to experience first hand God's care.



MINISTRY

In recent months God has allowed us to serve Him in different areas. In the month of January Hector and Eliana, in the midst of their sickness process, were able to accompany a medical brigade in the El Duraznal sector. Eliana was a translator and Hector shared the Gospel. It was a time of much learning for Eliana because she was challenged by God to let go of her fears and grow in her trust in the Lord.

Also, we have had the opportunity to continue with teacher trainings for the local church. Sunday school teachers have been trained for the church of Pozo Azul, and La Cayetana, villages of Siguatepeque, and the Church of God is Love in San Pedro Sula. In addition, we continue to support the training of leaders and teachers among the Lenca people in the Duraznal sector. In the last visit in February, we had a meeting with the teachers of the churches of La Laguna, El Duraznal and Quesuntega. It was so beautiful to hear the testimony of the sisters and to share that they enjoy teaching because God teaches them too and they have learned more of the Word of God, even with the limitations they still have with reading and writing. In some of the communities the children do not have a classroom in which to receive the class, so the class is taught in a field next to the church. The children walk up to an hour to get there, because they look forward to Sunday school.



HONDURAS

During this year, we will be accompanying the teachers to give them tools on how to teach creatively with the things they have around them and teach them how to study the Bible by themselves. We are also praying for provision to help them build a classroom and contribute with the minimum conditions for biblical teaching. On the other hand, we continue to walk hand in hand with God with the World Reach Online program. We are about to initiate a project to support pastors and preachers with a Bible Study Methods course. We continue with the online workshops for teachers with students from Honduras and Ecuador. Thank you for being part of what God is doing here in Honduras and outside of Honduras through the virtual classroom.



The situation of the country as in all countries continues to be difficult in the economic factor and security especially in some areas of the country. It is a political year since the elections are in November and that generates tension in the population. We ask for your prayers so that God may allow the situation to be an opportunity to grow and learn to walk with him and not to look at the things around us whether they are good or bad from our point of view. Let us pray that God will fulfill his purposes for his honor and glory.
