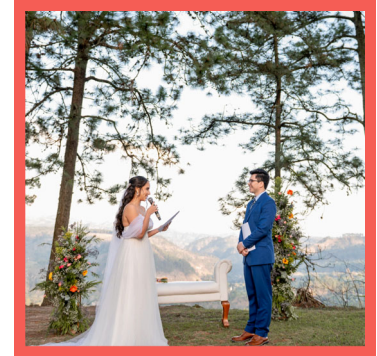
Ephesians 3:20

Leadership Under Construction



Leadership under Construction continues to grow! We are working on the third episode of the second season, and we already have an audience in **22 countries**, with almost **700 plays** of the available episodes. We are very grateful for these numbers, but perhaps my favorite number is **6**, as this is the number of members of the Leadership under Construction production team, which includes my wife Marcela, my sister Kyrien and 3 young people who are part of the youth ministry of the church. More than just a help in the podcast, this team is a great opportunity to further disciple these teens. I ask for your prayers because we are currently considering investing in equipment to raise the quality of the recording a little more.

Light on High

In February we had the opportunity to perform a skit of the song "You Say" by Lauren Daigle at a women's meeting. **2 people put their trust in Jesus Christ** because of this artistic expression.

In April we presented an evangelistic play near Easter, telling the stories of Peter, John and Mary Magdalene, talking about the change in their lives caused by the influence of Jesus. It was a powerful reminder of the power of Christ to change lives. We thank God that He used this play to bring **16 people to put their faith in Him**.

In May, so far, we have presented a monologue, where Marcela acted as Queen Esther, highlighting the courage it took to let God use her.

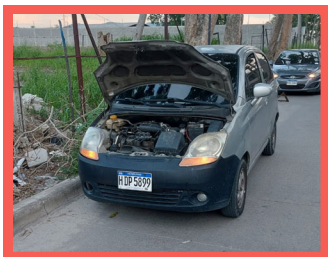


Baptisms

One of the happiest ministry moments of the last few months was the day we celebrated baptisms with some of the young people in our church. We had the privilege of seeing 9 teenagers get baptized, **4 of which were from our small group**. I had the great privilege of baptizing two of them. Glory to God for the steps of obedience that these young people have taken!



Some needs:



Through several trips to the mechanic, we have noticed that we should no longer demand so much of the car we have for personal and ministry use (pictured left). This car has been faithful, as it has helped us to take kids to group, to carry drama props, and for ministry trips. However, we are praying for a newer, larger car that has good gas economy; ideally, an SUV that is in service to the Lord and helps us for family use as well. After researching, we have concluded that the budget for a car with these characteristics is at least **\$12,000**
