**2. Peer Educators' Development Seminars:** This on-going seminar seeks to improve facilitation skills for these folks. It is also a session meant for teambuilding, mentoring and enhancing spiritual development. What a time of togetherness it was as we built our young people for the next steps ahead.



**3. Staff Development:** We thank God for the 6 schools that allowed us to develop their teachers professionally while retaining multiple opportunities to present the gospel. This has enabled us to reach about 170 teachers.

We were able to reach out to six schools where about 1400 students have participated in our seminars. We thank God for the lives ministered to and souls saved.
