Monica's mom has health problems and has been diagnosed with Alzheimer. She is now living with us. This means we are spending much of our time caring for her. Monica and I are balancing time with her mom and time in ministry, it has been difficult. We have considered placing her in a home to care for her, but we simply cannot afford it. We pray God guides us in making space to care for our family.

Our health: We have been trying to care for our own health. We want to give our best while being responsible with what falls to us, our home, family, and ministry. We thank God for our three children. They have been with us as we have lived our difficult moments, they have encouraged us spiritually. We praise God because our three children are walking with God. We are refreshed when we spend time with our granddaughters. God is so good, better said, He is better than good!



Ministry: In these past months we have participated in a missions' conference. We have also taught in a Bible Institute. I was able to teach in a retreat for men. We have had various opportunities to teach in churches. Monica and I have been invited to share our testimonies of our time as missionaries in the jungles of Colombia and Venezuela. We challenged those present to be involved in missions. My wife has also been very active in teaching women's meetings in churches. Both Monica and I have been involved in discipleship and counseling for marriages.



I would like to share a need with you. We have an urgent need to get a different vehicle. Our current vehicle has many mechanical, electrical and other problems. Each time I take my car to the mechanic he suggests I get rid of it because it continues to drain me financially. I need to raise about \$6,000 to purchase a new vehicle.
