Evangelistic Campaigns:

Over the past two months, we have shared the Gospel with the help short-term mission teams and our own members—children, youth, and adults alike—by going to different areas of our community. We not only thank God for the opportunity to do this, but also rejoice in seeing families getting involved and serving our Lord together for His Kingdom.



We've also gone to places where we hope to start new home gatherings to reach more families for Christ. This also allows our members not only to be part of the ministry, but to get involved in the lives of new believers. All of this leads us to praise Christ for His grace.

Training Pastors in Northern Peru:

I also had the opportunity to travel for a week to the highlands of northern Peru to teach and train pastors in the region.
