ANDRES & MONICA ACOSTA IN ARGENTINA



Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

We greet you with love and gratitude for your participation in our ministry and in our lives.

We want to share about our ministry as we are a few months away from celebrating 40 years in missionary work and 20 years with World Reach. We praise God for giving us the great privilege of serving Him.

In January 1986, God answered a prayer request we put before Him in two ways. First, He confirmed His will for us to serve Him together as a married couple. Second, He showed us the type of ministry we were to have, by showing us an example in the life of Sophie Muller. God confirmed all this to us, so many years ago, after much time of prayer and searching the Scriptures. God impacted our lives with John 15:16. *“You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, He may give to you.”* And to this day, His Word has prevailed in spite of many difficulties. Monica and I can confidently say God is God, there is none like Him!

This month marks 10 years of sending daily devotionals. We have sent them to many different people in many different countries. And they resend them

to people they know. It has been beautiful to hear the impact of these devotionals, their testimonies, of people who have given their lives to Jesus. Many have been edified, even in such inhospitable places like the jungles of Colombia, Peru and Venezuela. Also in isolated regions like in the mountains of Peru and Colombia. We can only imagine that it exceeds our hope and expectation, because only God can do such great things.

Recently we preached at a conference where 4 churches participated. We challenged them to be committed to loving Jesus. One of these was founded by a Bible Institute from World Reach. The church began with activities for children and out of that a church was born.

We also taught at a conference in Buenos Aires where many churches were represented. The title was “A Challenge to go to Missions with Good Results.”

Together Monica and I are discipling and counseling many people including couples. We continue teaching the Word of God in different churches. Monica teaches weekly in various women’s groups, both online and in person, and many are pastor’s wives. Her women’s Bible studies are in Buenos Aires, Peru and Mexico.



We also share with great joy that we have new ministry in the jungle of Colombia and Venezuela. World Reach recently established a Bible Institute on the Colombian side of the border. Church leaders from Venezuela are able to travel across the border to Colombia to attend. This is fruit from our ministry 20+ years ago when Monica and I lived and served in Venezuela. We planted churches. Now years later we see how the Lord has worked. We are able to train up the next generation of pastors and church leaders from Venezuela and Colombia. We are overjoyed! We participate in various activities to encourage ministry to youth, such as camps, and also communicate 3 times a week with church leaders to edify and multiply God’s work.

In early October we hope to update you again as we will have a remembrance service for Sophie Muller who passed away 30 years ago.



The call God gave us nearly 40 years ago remains a certain call on our lives. There is still much work for us to do . . . but over time our financial support has decreased. The Lord supplies all our needs! We invite you to prayerfully consider partnering with us to provide monthly support so that we can continue serving Him to the best of our abilities and for His glory.
