A few weeks before that Arianna (not in the picture) invited her classmate Enzo (also not in the picture) and he did receive Christ. And just last Saturday Sheyla brought two more university classmates, Alonzo and Maria Fernanda, and we were also able to share the Gospel with them. Here we are making "causa," a traditional Peruvian dish made of mashed yellow potatoes layered with steamed vegetables, shredded chicken, and mayonaise, after the Bible study. It's so much fun seeing them laughing and spending time together while NOT on their cell phones!

Of course eating isn't the only thing we do on Saturdays with the young adults. In October we started an inductive study of the book of James. Even though about half of our young adults grew up in church and have come to church all their lives, it's the first time they've ever studied a book of the Bible passage by passage and verse by verse. (Most sermons and Bible studies in Peru, even in good churches like ours, tend to be topical.) I absolutely LOVE seeing them starting to make connections between passages and understand verses in their context. It's so cool!

Beyond the young adult group, we continue serving in the school, Sunday School, discipleship, counseling, evangelism, preaching, and teaching. This week we had picture day for kindergarten graduation; that marks the start of the last couple of months of the school year, which are always very busy for us.

And for the everyday ministries; for discipleship, for counseling, for Sunday School, for the English Bible Study of Ephesians, for preaching and teaching, and evangelism.


