God's Work in 2025: A Snapshot in Numbers



This year, we witnessed God's faithfulness and His transforming work among children, youth, and leaders. Every camp, gathering, and teaching space became an opportunity to intentionally sow God's Word with eternal purpose. Throughout the year, 590 young people were exposed to the gospel through more than two hours of biblical teaching, receiving consistent and clear instruction in God's Word through camps, youth groups, and formative ministry spaces. We believe these moments of exposure are significant seeds that God is continuing to grow in their hearts.

With gratitude and humility, we are aware of at least 18 young people who have made a clear decision to follow Christ for the first time. While these are the commitments we can confirm, we trust that God is still at work beyond what we can measure or see.

In addition, we trained and discipled approximately 90–120 young people and church leaders, investing deeply in their spiritual growth, biblical foundations, and practical ministry skills so they can continue serving others.

This year also marked the launch of two new Bible Institutes, creating strategic spaces for raising up workers committed to God's Word and to His mission. We thank God for every life impacted and every seed planted, trusting that His Word will not return empty and that He will continue raising a generation passionate about the gospel and faithful to His calling.
