NOVEMBER PRAYER LETTER

Honduras

Dear Partners,

I hope that as you receive this new prayer letter, you are enjoying the mercies of our God, which are new every morning.

I want to begin by thanking God for His presence in our lives and the care He has shown us. After four long months of rest due to my fracture, surgery, and recovery, my ankle is now about 90% healed, and little by little we are returning to in-person ministry work.

Several weeks ago, I had the opportunity to preach again, at least locally. As most of you know, I am part of the World Reach missionary team in Honduras. We have a Mobile Bible Institute, and recently our entire team traveled to a place called Belén Gualcho, Ocotepeque—about a five- or six-hour drive. We went to give some short conferences with the hope of opening a new Bible Institute there.

I ask for your prayers for this place and that God would continue to use us in this noble work of training the saints for His service.

In the Mountains

Everything seemed to be going well in the mountains — many new believers, new communities opening their doors to the gospel, new leaders, and more. All of this happened during my four-month absence. Even though I was still recovering from my ankle injury, I couldn't resist the desire to go and see what was happening.

When I arrived, I realized that our common enemy never rests and had been tempting and attacking the ministry in the mountains. I suppose it was to be expected; it even seemed strange that there had been no attacks for a while. To make a long story short, I ask for your prayers—the enemy's attacks have come directly against the leaders and pastors, including their families.

Among these attacks are the destruction of their crops by wild animals, the poisoning of livestock they depend on for food, and even of domestic animals. In addition, there has been unfaithfulness in one of the couples, which has deeply affected one of the communities where we were working intensely. Please pray for these men and women who are determined to move forward despite the circumstances.



Concerning the ministry in the mountain kindergarten, please pray with us. This year, eight children graduated from the kindergarten, and we are expecting to have twelve new children next year. In this program, each child receives a small snack, and we also share the gospel with them and their parents. Please pray that God will provide the funds we need by January.

In Balibrea, in central Honduras, one of our churches runs a children's feeding center and a scholarship program for children and youth. Please pray that God will provide for these ministries as well.

At the end of November, Honduras will be holding elections for president, congress, and mayors. The political situation in our country is not good. Please pray for peace in Honduras and for the well-being of all who live here.
