John 1:14

Our wish is that the God who is near gives you a very blessed Christmas alongside your loved ones!

As I look back on this year and all that the Lord has allowed us to live and serve through, my heart keeps returning to this simple but astounding truth: Jesus chose to dwell with us. John uses a very intentional word when he writes that Jesus “dwelt” among us. The Greek verb is *eskēnōsen*, which literally means “to pitch a tent” or “to set up a dwelling place.” It is the same idea used in the Old Testament for the tabernacle, where God’s presence lived right in the center of His people’s camp. What a beautiful picture for this season. God didn’t stay far away from our struggles.

He didn’t send help from a distance. Instead, He pitched His tent right next to ours. He stepped into our world—with all its joys, pains, uncertainties, and hopes—and said, “I’m staying with you.” In Jesus, God made His home with ordinary people, in ordinary places, so that we could know His heart up close. This truth has encouraged me deeply as we continue serving here in Honduras. In every challenge, every step of faith, every moment of need, we are not alone. The same God who once walked among His people still chooses to draw near to us today, full of grace and truth. My prayer is that, in the middle of this busy season, you will sense Christ’s nearness in a fresh way. The One who became flesh still delights in making His home with His people.
