Taking Christ to the Nations

The word of God is alive and powerful. God uses it to guide us because He is our Good Shepherd. Hector was invited by a men's group at a Siguatepeque church to teach the Word. His teaching was based on Psalm 23, which explains six truths about God: He provides (v. 1), guides and gives peace (v. 2), restores (v. 3), accompanies (v. 4), blesses (v. 5), and gives us eternal security (v. 6). While the threats we face in the world are real, so is God's sovereignty. After the meeting, a man approached Hector. He explained that his family had been going through difficult times, and he identified with several of the threats mentioned in Psalm 23 (scarcity, fatigue, discouragement, etc.). But the night before the meeting, the man was praying and reading with his family. The Lord led them to Psalm 23. Hector's teaching reaffirmed and encouraged him to walk with the Lord because even in the midst of life's threats and difficulties, the Lord is his shepherd, and he shall not want. How powerful and relevant His Word is!

A couple of weeks ago, God gave Angelina the opportunity to accompany a woman who was facing difficult problems. She was looking for a quick answer and solution to her problem that would undoubtedly bring the desired results. Before having a meeting with the woman, Angelina began to pray and ask God for wisdom to help her connect with God. She asked God to help her see how He could help her and take control of the situation. After a few hours of praying and crying together, Angelina could feel her pain. The woman told her that God had shown her things she had never thought of before, that she could see God and the things around her in a different way. In the days that followed, Angelina noticed an inner peace in the woman and a desire to continue walking closely with God. Angelina is so grateful for the opportunity God gave her to begin walking with this woman and to rest in God's grace, growing together.
