The gospel was presented to 19,615 people!

This year, 962 people confessed Christ as Savior. We praise God for his work and power to change lives.

God has added to our World Reach family:

A new couple will serve in South Asia, taking the gospel to an unreached people group.

Summary of my travels:

My travels this year were to Honduras, Colombia, Eswatini, Kenya, and El Salvador.

Honduras

Team meetings with our four families in Siguatepeque and church planting among the Lencas.

Colombia

We gathered our team from Honduras, El Salvador, Peru, and Colombia to strengthen the family and their relationships with each other.

Eswatini, Africa

I was able to visit our new team member, Ngwane. He ministers to teachers and students in the public schools. I met with volunteers, donors, and school administrators and watched a workshop teaching school kids how to study for success. I preached to a high school and about 200 of the 900 kids present prayed to receive Christ. What a privilege!

Kenya

A team from Birmingham ministered to our kids at the World Reach Children's Home in Meru and our medical clinic team in Muthetheni. I taught our children about forgiveness and worked with our medical team regarding leadership in life and the clinic.

El Salvador

I participated in the church's 55th anniversary and led a missions workshop on mobilization for the advancement of the Kingdom. We looked at the early church in Scripture and saw that healthy churches are shaped by the Great

Commission and marked by generosity.

Locally:

Lolly and I finished teaching a study titled God's Design for Marriage at our local church. We are completing a new course to launch in January: Anchored in Truth: Life-Changing Biblical Doctrine. We will soon add studies for download on our website.
