

# NOEL & REINA GÓMEZ



Beloved collaborators in the Kingdom of our God, I write this letter to share with you that, after ten weeks of rest due to the fracture and surgery of my ankle—weeks in which God has allowed me to reflect and reevaluate the goals set for the ministry—I have come to the following conclusions:

First, I recognize that I am not eternal; at any moment He may call me into His presence.

Second, I must make the most of the time God grants me on this earth, using it solely and exclusively for His glory. And finally, the attacks of the enemy and the conflicts of this world must become opportunities for my spiritual growth, without allowing them to hinder the ministry. I thank God for providing, through some of you, for my surgery and subsequent rehabilitation. My rehabilitation has been difficult and painful, yet I thank you for your prayers and for those who have been asking about my health. We are better, thank God, and ready to continue working in the work of the Lord. We are also grateful to God for giving us wisdom and discovering that chocolate was the cause of my wife Reina's migraines.

I must confess that when I had my ankle fracture one of my first concerns was, "what are we going to do with the work on the mountain and with the local church?" But God manifested Himself powerfully, putting in the hearts of the brothers in the mountain and the local church the strong desire to move forward despite my condition.





That desire was so strong that they organized themselves (Men, women and children) to take the gospel to other villages, walking for several hours. This filled my heart when I received the news, photos, videos of the church moving to take the gospel to other villages. God responded to the concern in my heart when I had to have surgery on my ankle. Brothers and friends, I can only say God is good!! All the time!!

During this time Pastor Jesus Corea also received attacks from different sides; we know that the enemy wants to hinder God's work. One of the strongest attacks our brother received was the poisoning of his animals: dogs, horses and cows. I want to mention that our brother Jesus milked his cow and made cheese to sell and thus support his family. God allowed him to give an antidote in time to rescue his horses, but he could not rescue his cow. I ask you to pray for the care of pastor Jesus Corea and his family, also for all the leaders that God is raising among the Lencas. Right now, we have 16 leaders who are training in the knowledge of the Word of God and they are already taking the gospel to new places.

As most of you know, this year we started a kindergarten that works in the same facilities as the elementary school. I ask you for your prayers that God will provide for the expenses of this kindergarten for next year. We thank God for providing what is needed through the end this year. This has opened doors for us to be able to carry the gospel into the public school, and in this way we bring the message of salvation to the children and parents who come to see what is happening.

- Pray for the provision and protection of Pastor Jesus Corea and his family.
- Pray that God continues to provide for the different ministries (school scholarships, children's feeding program in Balibrea, kindergarten and snacks in the Lenca area)
- Pray for leadership on the mountain

- Pray that everything goes well and above all so that we have peace.
