Storytellers

June. A weekend with more than 100 young people from three cities being inspired by the story of Joseph's life. Joseph left his mark; he lived a life worth telling. We left this year's youth camp challenged, asking ourselves, What will your legacy be? What story will they tell about you?

"The Miracles of Jesus"



At the end of April, I was contacted by a Christian school. They invited me to direct a project they do every year: presenting a play involving the entire school. They mentioned that the theme of this year's play would be the life and ministry of Jesus. After about two and a half months of intense work every day, and preparing more than 200 children and young people, we presented



the play on July 6. To God's glory, it was a success, as the students brought their families, many of whom are not believers, to be exposed to the gospel. Glory to God for this great opportunity!

A couple of hard months (in every sense)

July was emotionally difficult, as my parents and sister moved to Dallas, TX. My dad will have the opportunity to expand his influence through teaching at Dallas Theological Seminary, and my sister will be studying psychology at Criswell College. Although I am very happy for them, the farewell was bittersweet. Please pray that God will use us all in the different places where He has us.

The summer was also physically exhausting due to the many trips out of town. Several of them were teaching opportunities, for which I am very grateful.

God shakes structures

Two things happened in recent months that represent a change in structure:

1. Our growth group had become very large in number, and it was necessary to split it into two groups. I stayed on to lead a group of about 15 young people.


