Dear Friends,

The last report card has been filled out. The last student has graduated. The

last paperwork has been filled out and submitted. Thank you so much for your prayers during December....thanks to you and the grace of God, we made it!

The last week of December and the first week of January are our favorite time of year. The rush of paperwork, exams, graduations, and Christmas programs is over; summer camps and VBS haven't started yet. It's a beautiful time to look back over the year that has passed and look ahead to the year to come.

As we look back on 2025, we are drawn over and over to the word "faithfulness." God has been so faithful to care for us throughout the year, sometimes in the most surprising ways! Our support has been low in 2025, and there was a moment when we weren't sure whether I (Keesa) would be able to register for my next class at Westminster. But an anonymous donor gave a donation that will cover almost the entire year of classes!

In ministry, too, God has been faithful, growing our young adults spiritually in ways that only He can, blessing us with two graduation ceremonies for the rural pastors in the Bible Institutes, allowing us to share the Gospel daily with our students at school, and in a big way with the parents at the graduation and closing programs.





Young Adult Ministry

But this "in-between" time isn't just about looking back; it's also about looking forward! We are so excited about the different ministry opportunities coming up in the year ahead. Here are a few you can be praying for:

Anniversary Program: this weekend, we will celebrate Filadelfia's anniversary. The three-day celebration will include a banquet on Saturday night and special music from each of our Sunday School classes and from several families in the church. It will be a beautiful opportunity to share the Gospel with friends and extended family members.

English Outreach: in March we will be starting a twelve-week introduction to English with four of the participants who completed the Ephesians study last year. We're hoping that these English classes will be an opportunity to share the Gospel with the participants.

English Curriculum for School: At La Roca, we are also making some changes to our curriculum, mostly in the way we teach phonics and reading. These changes will be based on Keesa's extensive study of the science of learning over the past few years, and they should make English easier for both the students and the teachers.

On that note, please be praying for more **English teachers** for the school; as always, we need more people (preferably native English speakers!) who have strong Christian testimonies and the desire to serve the Lord through teaching.

Bible Institutes: with the graduations last year, it's time for the Bible Institute to move to new regions where we can train and equip new pastors who wouldn't otherwise have access to seminary training. We have plans to start in a place called Huánuco (WA-noo-co) this year, and we are praying about three more possible locations in the future.

Of course we will also continue with our normal ministries during the next year; preaching and teaching, evangelism and discipleship, Sunday School, young adults ministry, and teaching at La Roca Christian School. Keesa will also continue taking her counseling classes at Westminster; this term she is taking Marriage Counseling, so she is looking forward to that!
