FEBRUARY 2026

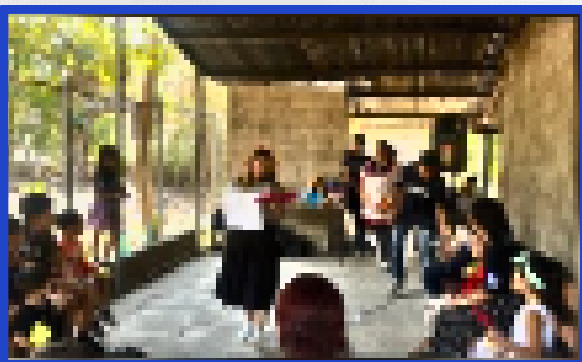


The way God works is miraculous. He has an extraordinary way of fulfilling His work here on earth. Many times, He joins brothers and sisters from churches in the USA and El Salvador for this work. I am always in awe of how God joins us to fulfill the great commission left to His church here on earth.

In January, a medical team from Stones Crossing Church in Indiana came to provide spiritual and physical help through medical clinics in four of the most impoverished communities in the western side of El Salvador. There were 27 medical team members from Stones Crossing Church and 33 helpers from my local church in Santa Ana, Family of Faith Church. It was a good team that included doctors, dentists, a nutritionist and children's ministry people. Every day, we saw about 200 patients, each with different needs.

We would begin the day with a devotional. Team members took turns sharing their testimony and then shared the Gospel. The team members from the local church would then have one-on-one conversations with the people there. It was a blessing for all!

When the week ended, members of the rural churches took part in activities to keep growing as disciples. The church "Las Delicias" held a special event for everyone who came during the medical team week. It was very successful!

In that moment I had a feeling, this is a little glimpse into heaven. Praise God for all the beautiful moments. When I think of the trip, I am filled with tears of joy and gratitude. I am forever changed."*
