- The podcast needs a lot of content to attract leaders. I've been praying for the idea river to have a strong, steady and most of all, relevant flow.

New year's anxiety

The year started, and with it, many thoughts: Will I be able to achieve everything that I'm setting out to do? Will I be able to reach every goal? Come December, will I be looking back on failures? These thoughts started nesting in my mind, and they made me feel anxious. I have a structure and a clear idea of how I want the ministry to go this year, and I started feeling scared about it not happening that way.

These first months of the year, my main focus has been the "Light on High" drama ministry. We started the year making a group chat of all the active members of the ministry. This year we have presented 5 skits at the church and had one drama mission trip, where 5 of us drove around 4 hours to meet with Briarwood Presbyterian church and present some skits at a children's home.

After this great experience, it was clear there was a need to have a "support team" for activities that are outside the routine skits. I started praying and talking to some people, and since we started, we have come across 3 opportunities to take the drama ministry outside of the walls of the church. Praise the Lord!



Teaching Opportunities

This year, the World Reach Honduras team has a Mobile Bible Institute in 2 locations (Belén Gualcho and El Carreto), and one Biblical School for Leaders (In Aguazul Rancho). This means a year full of opportunities of teaching leaders and pastors. Please pray for safety and wisdom for every teacher.

I will be teaching 4 classes this year. The first one happened in February, a class that in the past was taught by my parents and was now taught by Marcela and myself. We taught about how leaders need to have a Christ-like character. We had a great and blessed time with around 30 students.
