2. On-going Volunteer Development: After our annual February prayer and planning meeting, we started reading a book for our personal development, spiritual growth and discipleship. Every week we do a chapter and then have everyone answer a questionnaire developed for purposes of personal reflection for each chapter. We are now in chapter 6. Reading through the feedback/response, one is encouraged not only by their involvement but also by their honesty and hunger in wanting to know and serve the Lord better. The book is written by Gregg Hinzelman and is entitled, *What are you trusting God for?*

3. Staff Development: We thank God for the 6 schools that allowed us to develop their teachers professionally while retaining multiple opportunities to present the gospel. This has enabled us to reach about 220 teachers. Imagine the impact of a teacher who is not only developed professionally but whose heart has been stirred to mould and shape the life of a learner for now and eternity?

By opening their doors, these principals gave us an opportunity to positively influence the educators in their schools. Their support played a crucial role in the success of our efforts to benefit teachers.

4. Student Seminars

Through this initiative, we were able to reach out to six schools where about 4000 learners have been exposed to the gospel and more than 1200 students have participated in our academic enhancing seminars. We thank God for the lives ministered to and the more than 300 souls saved. We have testimonies of learners expressing being helped in setting their goals, priorities, managing time and learning effectively.

5. Campus Outreach

Remember Mlandvo Hlatshwayo, one of our mentees. *"Why is God so interested in me?"*, he had asked in one of our coaching sessions. Three years ago, in one of our student seminars, at Sibetsaphi High school to be precise, he was amongst the learners. Currently, he is a student in the University of Eswatini and through him, God has opened a door. We now have an outreach at the Campus, and we have met 3 times since beginning of March with an average of 10 learners in all sessions. We have a 1-day retreat coming on the 1st of May. Please pray for us to make maximum impact, as we continue with our campus outreach.



6. Parenting Sessions

Our support to schools has seen us do more sessions for parents this quarter than the whole of last year-unprecedented growth! Already we have reached out to five schools. These are 3 high schools (St Theresa, Ndzangu & Malibeni) and 2 primaries/elementaries (Othandweni Alliance & Mabhibha). In this 2-hour sessions, we engage parents on the challenges their children face and what role can they as parents play during this difficult phase of growth. How can they balance parenting responsibilities whilst offering guidance to the developing adolescent brain?

7. Meaningful Partnerships

We remain grateful to the Lord and impressed greatly by the positive outcomes resulting from our partnerships. Earlier this year, in collaboration with the Bible Society of Eswatini, we welcomed a guest from Lead Africa Network, Dr. Kirimi Barine, with whom we are working to strengthen leadership within our Kingdom. Through this initiative, we held sessions for Pastors and Church Leaders, the Inspectorate for Religious Education, as well as World Impact Volunteers and Board members. As part of this ongoing collaboration, this July we will be hosting a 2-day Christian Leadership summit.

8. Book of Hope

Remember our book of hope initiative! This was birthed by a session with our journalist who at the time World Impact had reached out to offer hope amid the challenges presented by the novel corona. *"How can I give what I do not have,"* asked Khanyi, one of the participants. Whilst COVID 19 is no longer a threat, uncertainty during our times is still prevalent. We have made this book a living document to look at some of the timeless principles we have learned from its effect. Our book is now being published, and we are trusting the Lord for its launch to be in July.
