Dear Friends,

March! Oh, my goodness, what a month this has been! March marks the start of the school year here in Peru, but also our "normal" ministries start back at Filadelfia. The start of the school year means documents to fill out... So. Many. Documents! I declare, if I ever walk away from teaching, it won't be because of the students; it will be because of the amount of paperwork required for every single class. Along with creating document after document, the start of the school year also means getting classrooms and teaching materials ready and of course meeting my new students! Because I teach first grade and K5, half my students are my former K5 students who have moved up to primary school; the other half are new-to-me in kindergarten, so getting to know each of them and their little personality quirks is always fun!

This year I get a special treat at school; Arianna, one of the girls from our young adult ministry at Filadelfia, will be working as a teacher's aid in preschool at La Roca. While she won't be in my class directly, I'll still get to see her every day. I'm especially excited about this because Arianna is my "spiritual grandchild"; I

discipled Jessica, and Jessica discipled Arianna. Please pray for Arianna and for all our teachers and aides at school this year!



## Our young adult ministry at Filadelfia

During the summer, we don't have regular weekly Bible studies with the young adults because so many of them are traveling or attending summer camps or participating in VBS or other ministries. We do, however, have a series of "fun" activities with them, such as ice cream nights, trips to the beach, and bonfires. We always include a short Bible message with each activity, but it isn't an intense Bible study like we do during the year.

In March, however, we started back our normal Saturday Bible studies with the young adults; right now we are studying the book of 1 Timothy with them. We've loved seeing them be challenged to put their faith into action in their church and community! We can't wait to share with you in upcoming emails some of the amazing ideas they've had to "serve like Timothy"!



## Project Vea gives us the opportunity to share groceries with the needy in our church and community

One new ministry Jorge and I have had the privilege of participating in is Project Vea. Here in Peru, large supermarket chains have a program where they donate unsellable goods (dented cans and boxes, fruits and vegetables

that aren't "pretty enough" to sell, day-old bread, food that is on the last day before its expiration date) to churches and non-profit organizations. It's a win-win situation; the supermarket gets a tax break for stuff it wasn't going to be able to sell, anyway, and the churches get free groceries for the needy in their congregations and communities. Last year we were able to get Filadelfia signed up for the program, so this year every Monday and Tuesday and every other Saturday Jorge drives about 45 minutes to the supermarket, receives that day's donations, and brings it home; I then separate it into roughly equal portions, and he takes it out to distribute it.

At Filadelfia, we feel strongly that Galatians 6:10 should govern this ministry; "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith." Because of this, our first priority with each week's grocery donation are the needy within our own congregation; widows, families who have lost their jobs, single mothers, and those struggling with illness or injury. But that being said, we often have opportunities to minister as well to those in need in our community, bringing them groceries and the Gospel. We would ask your prayers especially for Diana and Erika, two unbelievers we were able to minister to recently. Both are single mothers with children with disabilities and no support from the fathers (Diana has three children, two of whom have severe disabilities; Erika has two, one with a disability and one with severe health problems). We've been able to minister to both of them several times in the past few months; please be praying that beyond their physical needs, they would understand the depth of their spiritual need and turn to Christ.



As March closes and we look ahead to April, we would ask that you please keep us in your prayers for our upcoming ministry opportunities. Please especially be praying for our Easter Program; we will have a three-day evangelistic campaign and close on Sunday evening with a special musical called Flight of Grace, which presents the Gospel through a series of conversations and mishaps in an airport. Jorge has been working very hard to prepare the musical, so please pray that all would go smoothly, that everybody would remember their lines, that none of the singers would get sick, and

especially that God would use it for His glory to bring many people to Him.

Beloved friends, just as God's mercies are new every morning, so too is our gratitude for you...for your prayers...for your support...for your encouragement. We are so blessed to partner alongside you here in Peru. We hope our emails encourage you as much as you encourage us.
