Originally, we planned the mission trip to Bogota during the mid-year school break. When the government changed the vacation dates, we were concerned that it would make ministry less fruitful... But GOD knew best. The mission trip ended up being during the kids' first week back to school.

So, as we went forward with planning, we reached out to some local schools to see if they would be interested in having our team visit their schools. To our surprise, 4 schools said yes. When I say this is a MIRACLE, I am not exaggerating. It is unheard of for schools to allow outside groups in, and especially Christian groups. To our surprise 4 schools who profess to be Maristas (Worshippers of MARY), opened their doors and allowed us in. ONLY GOD!!!

We went into each of those 4 schools and preformed a Gospel skit, followed by a presentation of the Gospel. During 3 days, in 4 schools, approximately 600 students saw the skit and heard the Gospel. Many more students also heard the Gospel in smaller groups within the classrooms.

Unfortunately, this religion cuts Jesus out of the equation, but we are so thankful that each of these students heard the true Gospel, received invitations to our church plant, and had the opportunity to receive CHRIST as their Savior.
