Taking Christ to the Nations

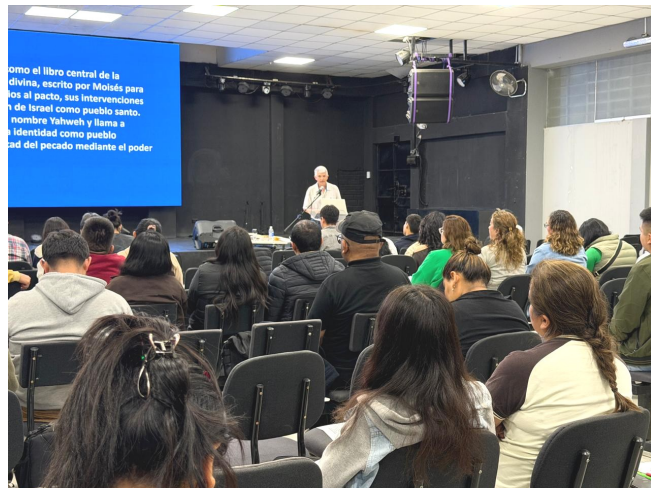


My students in the Huánuco, Peru BI

Dear friends & family,

Thank you for praying for my teaching trips to Huánuco, Peru in April and to Kayunga, Uganda in May. God tremendously blessed both courses that I taught.

From April 8-14, I taught a course on “Panorama of the Old Testament”, the first course in our new Bible Institute (BI) in Huánuco, Peru. It went very well & I had 50 students in my class. They worked hard during 4 days of class from Thursday to Sunday, with 16 hours of class teaching. It was a “flipped classroom” where the students worked on their course manuals for 2 months leading up to my visit. Then in class, I gave a 30 min. overview of each lesson (8 in all), then they participated in small group discussions & took a quiz on each lesson. The students did well, completing their manuals & taking a final exam which they sent to me by WhatsApp a week later. The next course in our Huánuco BI will be Inductive Bible Study taught by World Reach missionary Cristian Fuentes from July 2-5.

From May 1-8, I taught a course on Missions, Evangelism & Church Planting at our Kayunga, Uganda Bible Institute (BI) along with our Africa BI Director Isaac Kaimenyi. It was a great week & we had 25 dedicated students. Classes went from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday & the students took their final exam on Friday. They were excited & grateful for what they learned. I love teaching these students because they are so hungry for God's Word.

Here's a testimony from Robert, one of our students & a pastor of a church in Kayunga: ***"I would like to thank all of you who are sponsoring this program of World Reach, teaching us pastors because of what I've learned in the Missions & Evangelism course. The first thing I learned is that Missions or Evangelism is not only for professionals & special people but it is for all believers. So I've been teaching the church, encouraging every member... to carry on with Missions & Evangelism. Another thing is that I've been given relief because I've been evangelizing on the streets, one-on-one and in gospel crusades, and I would feel so bad when people don't respond when I make the altar call and they don't come... But I've learned that it is my responsibility to preach (the Gospel) but it's God's responsibility to save & bring people to Himself. So thank you so much - God bless you."***
